Brief Company Overview:	<p>Founded in 1997, ERRG is a minority and woman-owned, small business capable of performing emergency response services, engineering, remediation, construction, and military munitions response. ERRG has led and supported numerous projects for public and private sector organizations that include multiple United States federal agencies (US Navy, US Army Corps of Engineers, US Air Force, US Forest Service, and Bureau of Land Reclamation), and private utility companies; Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Hawaiian Electric Company, East Bay Municipal Utility District, and San Jose Water Company.</p> <p>We maintain a staff of approximately 270 full-time employees comprising environmental, civil, and geotechnical engineers; geologists; construction managers; construction superintendents; equipment operators; unexploded ordnance professionals; certified hazardous waste technicians; field laborers; and administrative personnel. Our team’s broad base of environmental, geotechnical, and construction backgrounds enables ERRG to provide our clients with a full spectrum of turnkey services.</p>

Relevant Project Summaries	<p>Gordon Valley Ranch Disposal Project, Napa, California. ERRG conducted cleanup of structures that contained potentially hazardous and biohazardous materials (including rat/bat feces to control potential hantavirus, mold, and veterinary medical waste). To prevent and contain hantavirus and toxic mold illness, ERRG disinfected/sanitized materials using a bleach solution prior to segregation and disposal. All work was performed wearing Level C PPE with full-face respirators.</p> <p>Cleanup and Abatement, Multiple Structures, Coronado National Forest, New Mexico. ERRG conducted cleanup of hazardous materials at three sites in Coronado National Forest on behalf of the Forest Service. The purpose of this project was to address potential hantavirus and LBP contamination at several structures and to rodent-proof the structures to the degree practicable. Cleanup activities were conducted in a phased approach, including sanitizing the interior of each building and all contents with a bleach solution; inventorying, segregating, and disposing of warehouse contents; and rodent-proofing each structure. Additionally, following disinfection of the warehouse, external panels were removed, the building was cut in half, and a new wall and roof panels were installed to renovate the structure for future use.</p> <p>East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) Emergency Response: ERRG has provided emergency response services to EBMUD throughout the east San Francisco Bay Area since 2015 under a General Environmental Services Contract. The emergency response work under this contract included containment, cleanup, and disinfection (as needed) for hazardous waste releases, biological waste discharges, and sewage spills. Contract value of \$3M over the 5 year period (2015-2020).</p> <p>Fire Debris Removal Rapid Response: ERRG has performed a wide variety of rapid response fire debris removal services to CalRecycle as a prime contractor and subcontractor, private homeowners, and municipalities in response to wildfire events in northern California in 2015, 2017, 2018 and 2019. ERRG has completed over \$8.7M in fire debris cleanup work since 2015.</p>

	Maintenance, Repair, and Construction of Facilities, Fairchild Air Force Base, WA. Between 2007 and 2012, ERRG was awarded 42 competitively bid task orders, totaling over \$7.5M for maintenance, repair, and construction of facilities supported by the U.S. Air Force. ERRG was responsible for developing task order-specific design submittals and deliverables, with most task orders involving fence and force/security protection issues, such as designing and installing a 3,400-foot 7-foot chain-link fence system, as well as repair, renovation, and construction of multiple facilities, including an auditorium, restrooms, training laboratories, warehouses, and an operation center.
